At 3<sup>30</sup> pm, on the first Saturday of each month, in Teynham School, including a hot supper (No connection with Teynham School needed)

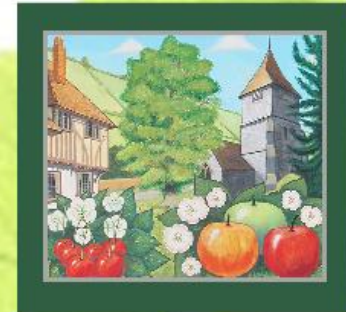


We also regularly run courses and enquirer groups. Please contact if you are thinking of getting married or having your baby Christened.

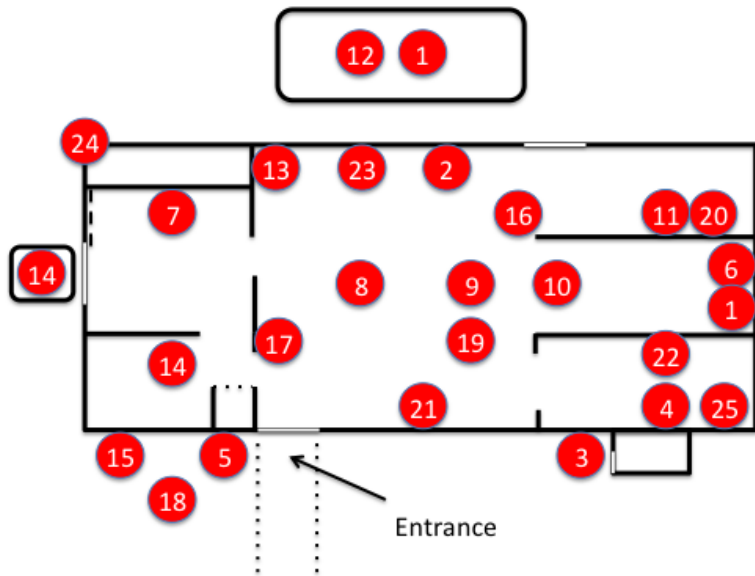
