WHAT YOU CAN DUMP AT A HOUSEHOLD WASTE TIP

Large items from your house that your dustman cannot collect, such as bicycles, bedsteads, mattresses, washing machines, sewing machines, radios, garden waste, do-it-yourself waste and refrigerators (*break the lock or hinge—it could save a child's life*).

OPENING TIMES

All Household Waste Tips are open at the following times:

MON-FRI	0800-1700
SAT	0800-1600
SUN	1000-1600

From **1 May—31 August** each tip will also be **open every Wednesday until 2000 hours.**

COLLECTION OF BULKY HOUSEHOLD WASTE

If you are not able to take your bulky household waste to one of the tips yourself your District Council operate a special collection service. A number of Districts make a small charge and some of these Districts are not able to accept all types of household waste.

WASTE OIL

Waste oil can be recycled. DO NOT put it down the drain or in the garden.



Kent has a county-wide scheme for you to be able to get rid of your old oil where you see this sign.

There are some 40 garages and 3 tips that you can take it to for disposal. If you would like to know more about

TRADE WASTE

Trade waste **must not** be dumped at household waste tips—it is illegal.

Trade waste is accepted at a number of County Council landfill sites, and will also be collected by District Councils. There is a charge for either of these facilities. For details please ring Maidstone 671411 Waste Disposal Branch.

UNWANTED CARS



It is dangerous and **illegal** to abandon cars. An unwanted car may be accepted without charge

at the County Council tips shown on Page 1. Your District Council will also be able to advise you of means of disposal for your unwanted car. A small charge may be made, but it could cost you much more if you abandon it anywhere else.

DUSTBIN WASTE

This is collected regularly by your District Council. **YOU** can help your dustman in the following ways:

- PLEASE** do not put liquids in your dustbin.
- PLEASE** wrap broken glass and other sharp objects in paper.
- PLEASE** see that all containers are firmly closed.

SAVE YOUR RATES

AND KEEP KENT CLEAN

PLEASE do not leave your waste outside the tips when they are closed—it is not only illegal, but also dangerous—*especially to children*.

PLEASE do not dispose of your unwanted goods by littering the countryside.
